Respiratory Therapy is a selective admission, limited enrollment program that admits one class per year. The application deadline for priority selections is February 28th of each year. If seats are available in the program following priority application reviews, secondary applications will be considered. The application deadline to be considered for the secondary selection period is April 30th.

The Respiratory Therapy program is designed to prepare students for a career as a respiratory care professional. The program is nationally accredited by The Committee on Accreditation for Respiratory Care (CoARC). As a Registered Respiratory Therapist, graduates may expect to find employment in home health care, acute and sub-acute settings, diagnostic laboratories, research, case management, sales, and asthma education.

The Respiratory Therapy program is delivered on-site at the Carver Career & Technical Center in Malden, WV. Completion of this program leads to an Associate of Science degree in Respiratory Therapy and eligibility for the Registered Respiratory Therapist (RRT) examinations.

#### **MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1) ACT composite of 20 or SAT composite of 950 or higher.
- ACT sub-scores of 18 in English, 19 in math, and 17 in reading OR SAT sub-scores of 480 in English, 510 in Math, and 480 in Reading OR <u>ACCUPLACER scores</u> of 250 in English, 263 in arithmetic math, and 252 in reading. If English or math scores are below acceptable levels, students must take and pass the appropriate math course with a grade of "C" or higher, as well as developmental English and/or reading courses prior to admission.
- 3) High school Diploma and High school GPA of 2.0 **OR** GED scores of 410 on each sub-test with an average of 450 **OR** TASC scores of 500 on each sub-test with the additional requirement to score at least 2 out of 8 on the Writing prompt.
- 4) One high school or college-level chemistry course with a grade of "C" or higher. The chemistry course does not require a laboratory component. If the student has high school courses only another high school science laboratory course with a "C" or higher is also required for admission **OR** 12 hours of college work at an accredited institution of higher learning within the past five years with a minimum overall GPA of 2.0. **Collegiate courses cannot include developmental courses.**
- 5) A one-page, handwritten essay detailing reason for wanting to be a Respiratory Therapist.
- ☐ 6) Two letters of recommendations.

#### STUDENTS WHO MEET THE ABOVE QUALIFICATIONS ARE REQUIRED TO:

- 1) Complete and submit a BridgeValley Community and Technical College application form.
- 2) Submit official ACT/SAT scores (may be on HS transcript).
- 3) Official copy of all high school transcripts **OR** GED Diploma.
- 4) Official copies of ALL college transcripts.
- 5) Mail BridgeValley and Carver application forms, ACT/SAT scores, official transcripts, essay, and this completed Respiratory Therapy Data Sheet to Respiratory Therapy Program, c/o Carver Career and Technical Center, 4799 Midland Drive, Charleston, WV 25306 OR to the Admissions Office, c/o BridgeValley Community and Technical College, 619 Second Avenue, Montgomery, WV 25136 by February 28<sup>th</sup> (primary selections) or April 30<sup>th</sup> (secondary selections).

Selection for the Respiratory Therapy program is based on ACT/SAT scores, high school/college coursework and GPAs, plus the handwritten essay and the letters of recommendation.
