door for West Virginia students to transfer to the Citadel and stay in their local communities."

By promoting and facilitating the transfer of courses taken at BridgeValley to The Citadel's School of Business and Evening Undergraduate Studies program, students will be able to begin their B.S. in Business Administration at BridgeValley and seamlessly transfer those units to The Citadel to complete their undergraduate program.

"This is an excellent opportunity for BridgeValley business studies' students to continue their undergraduate studies towards a bachelor's degree from The Tommy & Victoria Baker School of Business at The Citadel," said Management Program Coordinator Austin O'Connor. "This newly forged partnership demonstrates the importance of how a community college and a university can work together to serve students who can stay in their local communities while having greater opportunities to advance their educational goals and their future careers."

As part of the partnership, BridgeValley will offer courses academically equivalent to the lower division requirements of The Citadel's business administration degree offered through the Evening Undergraduate Studies program.

All students participating in the program who have a GPA of at least 2.0 and no less than a "C" in transferrable courses will be provided guaranteed admission into The Citadel's degree completion program, pending they are not ineligible to attend the school due to disciplinary or behavioral factors.

The new partnership went into effect at the beginning of the fall 2018 semester and will be reviewed annually by representatives of each institution.
